To the developers, the ZAD is merely a 'deferred development zone' since decades. To fighters, this is a zone to be defended (Zone À Défendre). Either way, the space is located in the countryside north of Nantes, in France. According to the Power, it should make way for industrialist plans, and particularly an international airport of Notre-Dame-des-Landes. The particular mega-project is in the hands of the multinational corporation Vinci, which also provides other 'services' worldwide, such as prison facilities, toll highways, nuclear power stations, and so forth. Many activists in the ZAD are not only in struggle against the airport construction, but resist the Capital, the State and any control over their everyday lives in general.

Committees from all over the region have met several times over the past two years to plan their reaction in case of a new attack on the ZAD or beginning of work. We will be ready to strike back if the moment comes. If there is confirmation of a massive police intervention a common callout will be published on zad.nadir.org.
