The product of over four years of work, with footage from three continents- this feature-length documentary follows the first year of a small collective in Buenos Aires struggling with assassinations, a collapsing economy, and a whirlwind of political upheaval. "i" is not just the first major documentary to explore Indymedia as a phenomenon in its own right- but the first to see the network as a unique key to understanding the deeper power and pitfalls of radical media everywhere.
