

12 October day of Indigenous Resistance and against Neocolonialism

The commemoration of the arrival of Christopher Columbus to the shores of the Americas on October 12, 1492 remains a matter of interpretation and controversy. cultural heirs of the European conquerors consider this the beginning of "civilization" in these lands. But for indigenous people it was the beginning of a war of extermination which imposed a colonial regime, to which they have opposed directly or underground. 12 October reminds us today that the old forms of colonialism still exist, sometimes with the same face, sometimes masked. 12 October reminds us today that indigenous peoples, alongside peasants, workers, unemployed, landless, and homeless people continue to oppose to the concentration of wealth in the hands of few and propose radical changes in the distribution of political, economic, social and cultural power.
